God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ...God divided the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night.





Yom Shlishi

Thursday

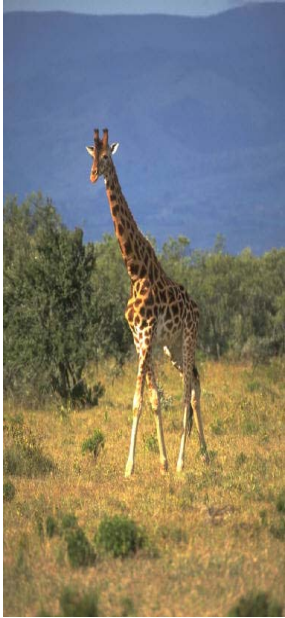
God created the large sea creatures, and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarmed, after their kind, and every winged bird after its kind.
